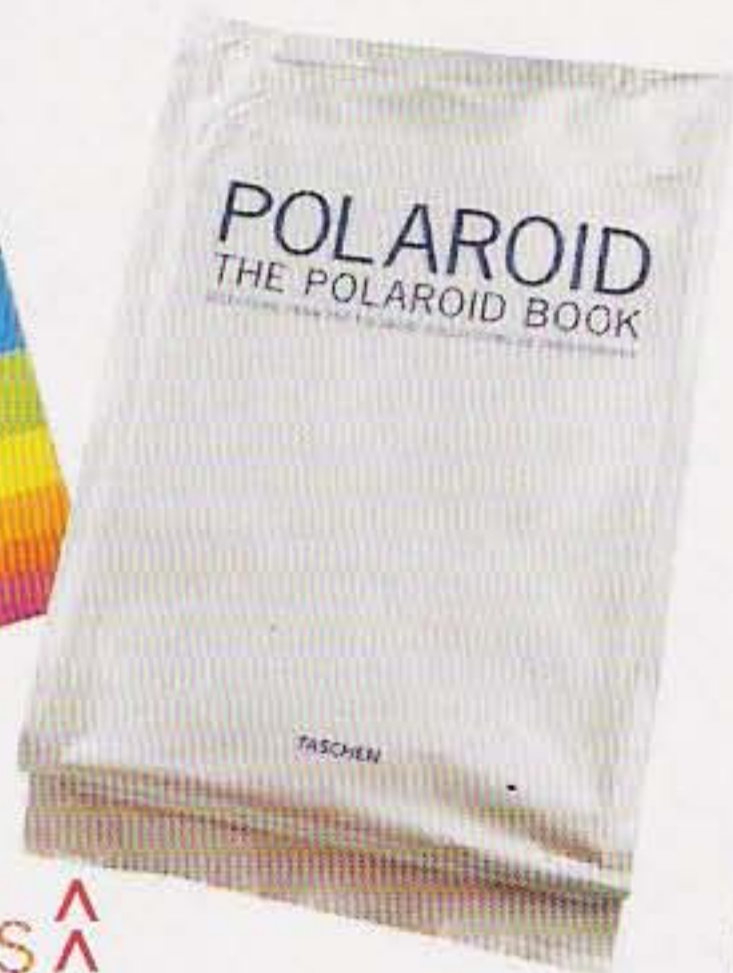
Silk Road ^
